

EQUINE POST.COM "EXPERT" PROGRAM TERMS & CONDITIONS

This document outlines the principles and standards governing the EquinePost.com "Expert" program. All Experts are expected to abide by these terms. By participating in the EquinePost.com Expert Program, each Expert acknowledges that he or she has read, understood, and agreed to these guidelines.

1. CONTENT

You agree to update your Expert page with a new topic-based article at least once each month. You also agree to list at least three outside resources (URLs) on your Expert page, and that you will regularly check the validity of any links posted on your page.
